Deer Tick's *Emotional Contracts* explores the existential challenges that arise with the passage of time, infusing each song with the band's trademark untamed spirit, honed over nearly two decades. Prior to collaborating with producer **Dave Fridmann** (The Flaming Lips, Spoon), the Providence-based quartet spent months crafting demos in a persistently flooded warehouse to shape the album's 10 passionately eloquent tracks. *Emotional Contracts* embodies the spirited energy of its creation, offering a poignant yet invigorating portrayal of aging gracefully without losing one's essence.
